What to pack for your Baja Tour

Do Not Bring:

Do not bring guns or drugs. Guns and drugs are illegal in Mexico so do not bring them! Please take extra care in packing your bags to make sure not to overlook anything to do with firearms or drugs. We will be subject to search by army soldiers during our time in Mexico. Thank you for your attention on this matter.

Luggage:

Gear bag or soft luggage works best on these tours instead of hard case luggage. All gear/clothing bags will be transported in our chase trucks - the less weight the better. If staying longer in the San Diego area, suggest leaving with any items not needed during the Baja portion of your trip in a suitcase at the San Diego hotel.

Rent Riding Gear:

Go Baja Riding has full custom motorcycle gear available for rent. Call today for options.

Bringing Own Riding Gear:

- If you are bringing your own gear, the following full off road equipment is required for safety.
*** Must bring Enduro style jacket (yes it's gets cold in Baja and could rain or snow. Really)
- helmet, goggles, gloves, elbow and knee guards
- MX style boots
- camelbak backpack with bladder or fanny pack to carry a water bottle
- kidney belt is recommended
- chest protector is recommended
- rain suit is recommended
- goggles should have a clear lens
- gear bag to carry all your MX gear

Clothes: Think layers

- Must bring Enduro style jacket (It gets cold in Baja and could rain or snow. Really)
- t-shirts
- sweatshirt or pullover
- jeans works everywhere in Baja
- casual shoes
- shorts
- swim suit
- sturdy sandals (tevas etc)

Misc Items:

- sunscreen
- digital camera, batteries, battery charger, memory cards
- sunglasses
- hat
- medications - in original bottle with prescription

Special Documents:

1) Passport or passport card. You will need of these to return back into the United States. No exceptions.

2) Copy of medical and/or dental insurance cards (could leave original car at home, bring paper copies)

Note: A Mexican Tourist Visa along with the above documents is required only if we are taking the 5-day Loreto Peninsula tour or 7-day Excursion to Cabo. For those tours we would stop at the border together and obtain the visa paperwork then. It's around \$20 US dollars for a Mexican Tourist Visa.

What is the motorcycle “Crash Damages Deposit”?

Bring \$300.00 CASH for the Crash Damages Deposit. This cash deposit will be collected from each rider on the first day at the riders meeting. Any damage to your bike will be deducted from this deposit at the end of the tour. No exceptions.

How much cash should I bring?

As you know your adventure tour with Go Baja Riding is all-inclusive! We take care of your transportation to and from Baja Mexico, your bike, gas, hotels, and all meals (mixed drinks and beer excluded). There may be opportunity in Ensenada to go shopping. Small bills (\$1, 5 10, 20's) are best so local vendors can make change easily.
